Description	In March 2022, Rubí Town Council began to develop a new project with a local sports organisation, the Club Escola de Fútbol Can Mir.  This project is part of the European Union's Erasmus+ programme and has other international partners such as the

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	Associazione Sportiva Bresso 4 from Italy, the KCS Machelen from Belgium and the Instituto Superior do Gestao from Portugal.  This social integration project aims to break down the barriers that limit the inclusion of young migrants in society and prevent them from having a "normal" life in Europe.  The participating clubs already have experience in organising activities for minors at risk of social exclusion and will therefore also carry out exchanges between members of these entities in order to share experiences and learning that can benefit the projects they have already been carrying out.
